



Zhangjiajie National Forest Park

Description

Zhangjiajie National Forest Park is located in Wulingyuan District, Zhangjiajie, Hunan Province, China. Covering 4,810 hectares, the Park offers rich natural scenery, including unique vertical rock formations arising from a dense primary forest. In December 1992, it was added to the "World Heritage Site" list, and in 2004 listed as a Global Geopark thanks to its peculiar geological features.
